REGISTRATION ELIGIBILITY

Recreation programs are restricted to residents of the Village of Tarrytown and / or children who attend the Tarrytown School District. The Recreation Department will supply flyers, applications and any information to all interested parties. The Recreation Department reserves the right to limit registrations to a "first come, first serve" basis due to limited space for certain activities / events. The Recreation Department maintains a policy which requires individuals to help defray the costs in offering certain programs. The fees for each specific program have been established based on operating costs, the nature of the activity and the number of individuals the program will benefit. It is also the intention of the Recreation Department that no Village of Tarrytown resident be denied the ability to participate in any program because of financial constraints. Please contact the Tarrytown Recreation Office to discuss your individual situation.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

For all programs, **AGE REQUIREMENTS** will be as of the date of the event or program unless otherwise specified. Please do not request or sign your child up for a program that he / she does not belong in. All age requirements are set to benefit the children and make instruction more consistent for the program leader. Thank you for your cooperation.

ENROLLMENT

For the majority of our programs to be conducted, a minimum enrollment must be reached. In some cases, there is also a maximum number of participants allotted based on facility space and the instructor's requirements. Therefore, registration is always on a first come, first serve basis. We encourage you to register early as some programs tend to fill up rather quickly.

LIABILITY

Participation in any of the activities of the Tarrytown Recreation Department is done so at the individual's own risk.

FORMS OF PAYMENT

The Tarrytown Recreation Department accepts cash, checks and now MasterCard and Discover Card as a form of payment for our programs and trips.

Please Note: There is a service fee of 2.45% when using one of these credit cards.

REFUNDS

Refunds are issued only for the following reasons:

- ◆ A full refund will be issued for any program canceled by the Tarrytown Recreation Department.
- ◆ A refund request because of illness or an injury must be accompanied by doctor's note.
- ◆ All refunds will be prorated based on the date received, with a \$10.00 processing fee attached.

PROGRAM BEHAVIOR

All registered participants are expected to exhibit proper behavior at all times. The following guidelines have been established to help make our programs safe and enjoyable:

- ◆ Show respect to all participants and staff.
- ◆ Refrain from using profanity and inappropriate language.
- ◆ Respect all equipment, supplies and facilities.

WAITING LIST:

The Recreation Department will make every effort to accommodate those on a waiting list for a program. If an opening does occur, the Department will contact those individuals on the waiting list.

PLEASE RESPECT VILLAGE PROPERTY

The parks belong to you, the resident. We ask that you treat the parks as you would treat your own back yard. Please take a few moments to discuss with your children how to respect public property. Be mindful to pick up and dispose of all trash in a proper manner. Please refrain from climbing trees and touching flowers and shrubbery.

FOR THE DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED

The Tarrytown Recreation Department, through the Greenburgh Parks & Recreation Department and in cooperation with the New York State Office of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities, offers a variety of recreation programs for those who are developmentally disabled. In order to participate in this program the following is required:

- ◆ You must fill out the Special Recreation Annual Information Form.
- ◆ New program participants must have a personal interview by the Director of Special Recreation with the prospective participant and parent / guardian.

The Town of Greenburgh and its incorporated Villages, including Tarrytown, have entered into an inter-municipal agreement to share facilities and resources for providing therapeutic activities for our developmentally disabled residents.
