Dear Resident,

Now that leaf season is upon us, it is imperative that village residents follow the rules and regulations concerning leaf collection. Following these simple rules will help this year's leaf collection to be more efficient and cost effective.

1. All leaves must be placed **CURBSIDE** for collection and not in the roadway along the curb.
2. Brush and other objects must not be placed in the leaf piles. Piles containing brush, vines and other large objects will not be collected.
3. If you chose to bag your leaves, only leaves in biodegradable leave bags will be collected. Leaves in plastic bags will not be collected.
4. Brush shorter than four feet placed out for collection must be bundled and tied with suitable string and must not contain any metal or wire. Brush placed loose at the curb will not be collected. These bundles of brush must not be placed in or on leaf piles.
5. Branches longer than four feet in length will be collected separately. These branches must not be placed in or on leaf piles. Please call and schedule an appointment 914-631-0356.
6. Failure to follow these simple rules can result in violations being issued.
