Local Law Number __ of 2017

Public Notice

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown will hold a public hearing on the 16th day of October, 2017, at 8 PM, in the Municipal Building, One Depot Plaza, Tarrytown, New York 10591, to hear, discuss and to act upon a proposed amendment to Chapter 221-3. Swimming, wading and boating of the Code of the Village of Tarrytown. A summary of the legislation is available at Village Hall. The complete text of this legislation follows:

A local law to amend Tarrytown Village Code Chapter 221-3. Swimming, wading and boating to provide residents, with a boating permit, permission to utilize non-motorized boats, canoes and kayaks on the lower eastern most Tarrytown Lake.

Be it enacted by the **Board of Trustees** of the **Village of Tarrytown** as follows Language in **Bold** to be added, language in [parenthesis to be deleted]:

- § 221-3. Swimming, wading and boating. [Added 8-17-2015 by L.L. No. 5-20151]
- A. No person shall swim or wade in any body of water or waterway in or adjacent to a designated park or open space.
- B. No person shall bring or operate any boat, canoe, kayak or other watercraft or any floatation device upon any body of water or waterway in or adjacent to a designated park or open space unless the Village directly authorizes such use and establishes a location for the launching and use of such boat, canoe, kayak or other watercraft or any floatation device.
- C. Residents, upon obtaining an annual village permit, may utilize nonmotorized boats, canoes and kayaks in the lower Tarrytown Lake. Permits may be obtained from the Recreation Department or the Treasurer's Office during normal business hours.
- D. Annual permits issued by the Village must be visibly displayed and permanently affixed to the right side of the watercraft's bow.

E. Boating is permitted from April 1st thru December 31st between ½ hour before sunrise and ½ hour after sunset.

F. All persons utilizing the Tarrytown Lake for boating purposes must adhere to the policy adopted by the Village Board of Trustees on July 17, 2017 regarding the Resident Only Use of Non-Motorized Boats, Canoes and Kayaks in the Tarrytown Lakes. Said policy is maintained on file in the Village Clerk's Office.

Section 2: Severability

If the provisions of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this local law shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this local law.

Section 3: Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

All interested parties are invited to attend and be heard. Access to the meeting room is available to the elderly and the handicapped. Signing is available for the hearing-impaired; a request must be made to the Village Clerk at least five days in advance of the meeting.
