
Let's Make great choices for getting around the village

As part of the construction of the New NY bridge, there are plans to improve and expand the way we may move around Tarrytown. These include **BRT** [Bus Rapid Transit], and a local trolley or **IOOP** around the village, connecting the many trails and walkways in and around the village, improving sidewalks and bike lanes. With **Beeline** in service, there

will be many options for getting around the village and the region.



What is **BRT**?

BRT is Bus Rapid Transit - a bus ride that is more like riding a train. Routes between Rockland, Tarrytown and White Plains would be smooth, quick and cost effective. Off-board fare collection (like the ticket stations on the train platform), comfortable seating, wifi on board, signal priorities for faster, reliable and direct service makes it a good choice instead of driving and having to deal with parking.



BRT service includes: • pre-paid or electronic passes for faster, easier fare collection

- Stations and shelters with rider conveniences (weather-proofing, heat, announcements)
- Running ways: improved road lanes with dedicated HOV priority for faster travel time
- Greener vehicles running on alternative fuels for a cleaner and quieter trip



This could be Tarrytown. You want to go to White Plains to shop and you don't have 18 quarters to feed the meters? Take BRT so you don't have to park, or drive, or get stuck in traffic. You'll have the choice.
