

Village of Tarrytown Legal Notice

REQUEST FOR BIDS

CONTRACT # 2017-05

Furnish & Deliver One (1) New
36' Fire Resource and Rescue Boat

Please take notice that the Village Administrator of the Village of Tarrytown will receive proposals at the Tarrytown Village Hall, 1 Depot Plaza, Tarrytown, NY, 10591, until 1 p.m. E.S.T. Wednesday, December 20, 2017, for one (1) New 36' Fire Resource and Rescue Boat, Delivered. Deviations from the enclosed specifications must be justified by documentation provided by the bidder, and deemed acceptable to the Village of Tarrytown.

This fire and rescue boat shall be marked out in a color and identification that is acceptable to the Village of Tarrytown Fire Department, based on the enclosed specifications.

Key specifications that must be complied with include the following:

- 36-foot Fire Resource and Rescue Boat
- Two (2) Mercury 350 HP Outboards with 25" shaft per manufacturer specifications
- Fuel system and tanks must meet all EPA requirements
- The boat shall have an expected service life of 25 years, subject to good maintenance and the hull shall come with a ten year warranty.
- Repair location for warranty repairs to be identified within ten (10) nautical miles of the Village of Tarrytown

Bid Deadline is 1 p.m. E.S.T. Wednesday, December 20, 2017. All bids must be in compliance with the specifications attached herein in such a manner that they are acceptable to the Village of Tarrytown.

INFORMATION AND NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The bidder in submitting his/her bid agrees to enter into said contract with the Village of Tarrytown, if he/she is the successful Bidder for the apparatus specified to be provided in accordance with his/her bid.

The signed bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and plainly marked,

“Tarrytown 36' Fire Resource and Rescue Boat – CONTRACT # 2017-05”

The Bidder must submit a proposal with a lump sum price on the form supplied, calculated to the bid grand-total, in the space or spaces provided for same, both in figures and in words. Whenever a price in figures differs from the price as stated in words, the price written in words will be considered to be the bid price that governs.

All bids must be signed by the Bidder.

The Village reserves the right to consider all bids submitted for a period of thirty (30) days and no bidder will be permitted to withdraw the bid during this period. The Bidder may take specifications and bidding pages apart, but must return the entire package complete with any and all attachments made to the package.

The Village of Tarrytown is exempt from payment of all Federal, New York State and Local taxes. Exemption certificate(s) shall be provided upon request. This purchase is funded in part by a grant in the amount of \$325,000 from the NYS Dormitory Authority.

A bid bond, certified check, bank check or cash in the amount of 5% of the total bid must be submitted with the bid proposal.

The Bidder is to familiarize him/herself with all provisions of these specifications, and shall not at any time after submitting his/her bid, dispute any of the specifications or assert that there was a misunderstanding in regard to the furnishing and delivering the apparatus called for in this request. No bid/proposal will be accepted from, or contract awarded to, a Bidder in default upon any obligations to the Village of Tarrytown.

The Village of Tarrytown Board of Trustees reserves the right to select the bid, the acceptance of which will in their judgment, best secure the fire resource and rescue boat called for in these specifications, or which will be for the best interests of the Village of Tarrytown (irrespective of whether it is the low bid, or the high bid, or otherwise), or to reject any or all bids. Proposals which are incomplete, conditional, or obscured, or which contain conditions not called for, erasures, alterations, or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected as informal, or may be waived at the discretion of the Village if any informality is deemed immaterial and non-prejudicial to the Village of other Bidders.

Upon acceptance by the Village, this bid with all attachments, conditions, and specifications, shall constitute a contract between the Village and the contractor.

This bid notice, information for Bidders, and specifications, all annexed hereto, are part of this contract.

The Bidder shall comply with all applicable local and New York State laws, if any, in the performance of this contract.
