

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 2016
SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown held a public hearing on the 21st day of November, 2016, at 8 PM, in the Municipal Building, One Depot Plaza, Tarrytown, New York, and adopted Local Law No. 7 of 2016 to amend the Code of the Village Tarrytown, Chapter 269 entitled "Taxation". The complete text of the legislation is available at the Village Clerk's Office, Village Hall, One Depot Plaza, Tarrytown, New York 10591. A Summary of this legislation follows:

A LOCAL LAW to amend the Code of the Village of Tarrytown, Chapter 269 entitled "Taxation", to add a new Article VIII to terminate the Village's status as an assessing unit.

On or after the effective date of this local law, the Village of Tarrytown shall cease to be an assessing unit.

The position of Assessor in the Village of Tarrytown is hereby abolished.

The Board of Assessment Review in the Village of Tarrytown is hereby abolished.

On or about the effective date of this local law, taxes in the Village of Tarrytown shall be levied on a copy of the applicable part of the assessment roll of the Town of Greenburgh with the taxable status date of such Town controlling for Village purposes.

This local law shall take effect thirty days after its adoption; unless, pursuant to New York Village Law § 9-902, within thirty days after its adoption there be filed with the Village Clerk a petition signed and acknowledged by electors of the village in number equal to at least twenty per centum of such electors in the village, as shown on the register of electors for the previous general village election, protesting against such act or resolution and requesting that it be submitted to the electors of the village for their approval or disapproval.
