Tarrytown does hereby award the Soil Borings for the Crest High Service Phase 1 – Water Main Replacement project to Soil Testing, Inc. per their proposal of \$19,360.50.

WHEREAS, due to the cost differential in the bids, it is the recommendation of the consulting engineer and staff that the bids be rejected and the project be rebid.
