Prescription drugs	. Bin at Police Dept.
Electronics (some!)	Tarrytown Recycling Center
Rugs	Donate or Trash
Wax and parchment paper	Food Scrap Bin

Hazardous Items: Dispose at H-MRF or Appropriate Vendor

Do not dispose in trash or recycling. *Empty* containers that held hazardous materials go in the trash (not in recycling).

- Aerosol and spray cans (not empty)
- Chemicals (e.g. drain cleaner, pool)
- ✗ Batteries (all non-alkaline)
- ✗ Bulbs: CFL or fluorescent tube
- Propane or fuel (including tanks)
- × Herbicides and Pesticides
- ✗ Motor oil (vendor only, not H-MRF)
- ➤ Polish (metal, silver, etc.)
- ✗ Solvents and acids
- Stains and varnish
- **×** Thermometers
- **×** Tires
