FUND RAISING FOR PATRIOTS PARK

On Monday, January 7th, Jim DeSimone, Chairman of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Council, and I met to discuss initiating a fund-raising effort for Patriots Park, with the goal of funding the installation of a band shell. There is significant interest in this from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Council as well as from other interested parties who make frequent use of the park. Coming up with an estimate of \$100,000 for the purchase and installation of the band shell and all the grade work related to it, we were trying to think how we could accomplish that using funding streams available to us, particularly since we were not able to do this installation as part of the recent state-funded project to upgrade the playground equipment and other things in the Park. In addition to the band shell, the Mayor and Anthony Ross and I have discussed a grass paver type of mesh strip along the roadway. This would allow the use of the park for things like the Farmers Market and reduce damage caused by vehicles driving on the grass or heavy foot traffic behind tables. Coming up with a plan, Jim and I thought about a brick paver fundraiser with engraved bricks installed with names engraved on the bricks. We estimated that people making the donations could raise as much as \$200,000 for this project. This is using an estimate of a 20 x 20 paved area and using an area calculation of five bricks per square foot. At 400 square feet times 5 bricks, it would be 2,000 square feet times \$100 which is \$200,000. The question is do we have any partners who we could work with in order to raise these funds, or should the Village explore creating a 501-3c Friends of the Tarrytown Parks not-for-profit organization so that people can make tax deductible donations and the Friends of the Tarrytown Parks can solicit and raise funds.

Discussing this further with Jim DeSimone, we thought this model could also work in Patriots Park for the 911 Memorial down in the hollow area by North Washington Street, with a similar cost and revenue calculation.

Jim DeSimone, as Chairman of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Council, will be attending the work session to discuss this with you.
